CAMPUS SECURITY ACT INFORMATION DISCLOSURE & ANNUAL SECURITY REPORT

Under the Crime Awareness Campus Security Act of 1990, as amended by the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act), we are required to provide all students and faculty with the following safety information about our campus. This Annual Security Report has also been updated to reflect recent changes in crime reporting, policies and procedures required by the Violence Against Women Reauthorization Act of 2013 (VAWA) effective July 1, 2015.

Installer Institute is committed to providing safety to all of its students, faculty, and staff. If a crime happens to the student or the student's property or if there is an emergency occurring on campus, report the incident to Director immediately. That Director will assist the student or guest in reporting the crime to the local police or other appropriate security force.

Installer Institute will provide students, faculty, and staff with a copy of this crime report from the previous calendar year by October 1st of the following year. Statistics will be gathered from the local police and compiled in the annual report.

The report will show the number of incidents on campus, including housing facilities, parking lot, and adjacent streets. At any time, statistics can be accessed from Installer Institute's Admissions Office or on its website, www.installerinstitute.com.

Although Installer Institute does not employ security personnel, Installer Institute has a working relationship with the local police who are able to support and provide services promptly in the event of an incident. We encourage accurate and prompt reporting of all crimes to the local police.
